

Natural increase is the difference between births and deaths. Other increase is the difference between the total increase and the natural increase, which includes the expansion of the research area and the increase–decrease for other reasons other than the excess of entries over exits. The excess of entries over exits from October 1950 onwards is the difference between legal entries and legal exits based on the statistics of immigration control. Annual rate of growth (%) was computed by the formula $(\sqrt[n]{P_1/P_0}-1) \times 100$. P_0 and P_1 represent the population at the beginning of the period and the population at the end of the period, respectively. n represents the period.


