It was originally published as the *Review of Social Policy*, but the name has been changed after an organizational change. The *RPSP* aims to publish research articles on population and social policy contributed by staff researchers and guest scholars.

The National Institute of Population and Social Security Research is a government research organization, affiliated with the Ministry of Health and Welfare. It was established on December 1, 1996 through an amalgamation of two institutions, the Institute of Population Problems and the Social Development Research Institute.

The principal purposes of the Institute are to serve as a bridge between scholarship and public policy, to bring new knowledge to the attention of the public, and to contribute to an increase in the welfare of the nation, through research in the relationship between population, economy and social security.
