## Consideration of the Background of Long-term Care System Diversity and its Possible Future Development Direction under Rapid Population Ageing in Japan, China, and South Korea

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In East Asia, where the population ageing has been proceeding rapidly, construction of long-term system has become an important policy challenge. Japan, South Korea, and China in East Asia have developed each long-term care system with diversity. But, there are commonalities such as the adoption of a social insurance system among them. Japan experience has been referred in long-term care service provision and community-based care system for South Korea and China.

In this paper, I have analyzed the diversity of long-term care system in Japan, China, and South Korea from the perspective of its system components. I have found the results as follows.

- 1) There are strong commonalities in system components with limited policy options such as financial methods.
- 2) There are strong differences in system components such as long-term care provision. It is because that each country can decide its system in detail based on the socio-economic and older person's social welfare development status.

With the combination of these commonalities and differences, the diversity has been brought to long-term care system in Japan, China, and South Korea. At the same time, I have considered the possible directions for the development of the long-term care system in these countries with rapid population ageing in the future.
